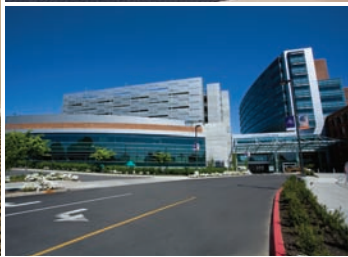
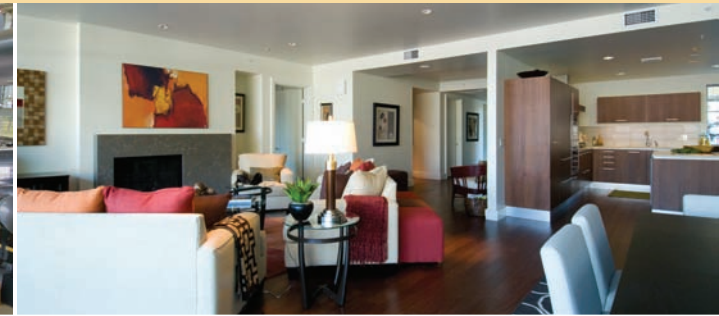

REQUIREMENTS

- High School diploma or GED.
- Previous experience in surface preparation and installation of carpets, resilient materials, laminate flooring, pre-finished wood, decorative coverings and all trims necessary for correct installation.
- Journey Level status or willing to take a skills test to determine level of expertise. (Wages are based on levels of expertise.)
- Knowledge of the floor covering industry environmental and safety regulations and be physically able to do the work of the trade.
- Employers may require pre-employment drug testing and background checks.
